Discussion of the roof at GMS

Mr. Keith Grinnell, Operations and Maintenance Coordinator, said that the district is beginning to receive quotes for architects. A structural engineer went over the blueprints and said that the roof can sustain having another layer of shingles added to it, if that is the way the board would like to go. There is a 40-year warranty on the shingles, but the installation/workmanship warranty is only for two years. Mr. Grinnell will find out if it is possible to extend the warranty on the workmanship.
