Update on student enrollment- Chris Bobek CSBO distributed historical data from 2011-2017 regarding student enrollment. The current student enrollment as of the board meeting was 3819. Jill Alfrejd asked if the district could get the number of new student enrollments after central registration took place, she felt this could help determine if our community outreach is working prior to central registration.
