New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review of the adequacy dollars and the district priorities- In May, the General Assembly passed Senate Bill 1. This research-based funding formula will provide fair funding for districts across the state. Districts will be reviewed on 24-27 evidence-based targets. Districts will be held accountable for the spending of these funds. Ellen shared the Board priorities from the spring of 2017 and asked them to consider what priorities they would like to implement provided funding is available. Further discussion will be held at a future Board meeting.
