Health, safety and environmental benefits of walking to school are why the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) asks that your school be involved in next month's International Walk to School Day. The event aims to encourage safer and improved routes to school, along with healthier habits and environmental awareness for students

This year's annual International Walk to School Day is Wednesday, October 5th. Schools that plan to participate are asked to spend time instructing students on pedestrian safety prior to the event. Teachers, faculty, and parents can also participate.



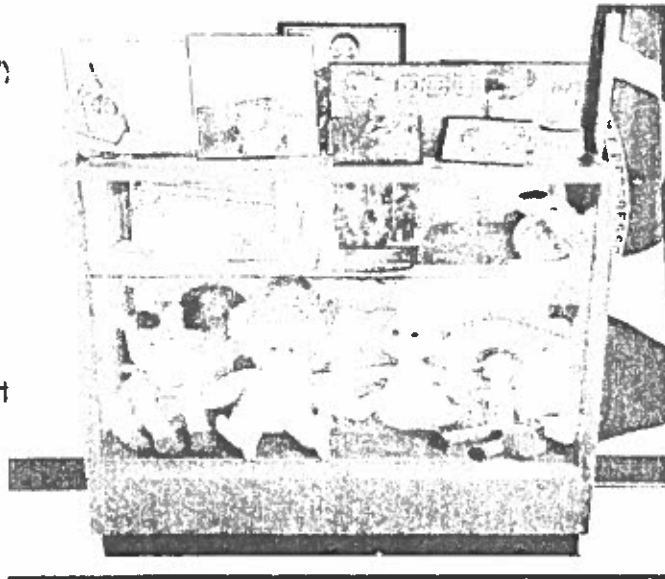
A WORLD TO DISCOVER AT MEADOWVIEW 2016-2017
